Prior to admittance the prospective student receives:

Description	The active directory account is created at this point. When	Exactly four weeks prior to the first class meeting date (automated process if prerequisites are met).
Prerequisites	Academic Records must have set the actions RECLRG or RECLRU.
Notification	Email is sent to the student's personal and SWU email accounts.

After Graduation

A notice will be sent explaining that the account will be removed. Approximately 60 days after graduation, the account will be deleted. The student will still have access to mySWU for alumni access and access to grades and transcripts. All other access will be removed. Graduates will have to access mySWU using their ID number in the same way that candidates must do so.

Permanently Withdrawn Students

These accounts will be removed <u>two months after their permanent withdrawal date</u>. They will continue to have access to mySWU using their ID number, as described in the candidate section of this document, to access items like grades and transcripts.

Resetting Student Passwords

If a student cannot access their account, defer them to Resetting Password for mySWU.
